


HISTORY OF STORYTELLING

It might have a story to explain the creation of the world, the turning seasons, or the coming of birth or death.



Down came pussycat, away Robin ran,


Says little Robin Redbreast, "Catch me if you can."

Pussycat said "Meow", and Robin flew away.









EMERGENCE OF TONGUE-TWISRER

Tongue Twister means a word, phrase, or sentence difficult to articulate because of a succession of similar consonantal sounds





EMERGENCE OF TONGUE-TWISRER

It is hard to speak fast, usually of alliteration or sequence of nearly similar sounds.








EMERGENCE OF TONGUE-TWISRER


They have been used to train radio announcers, to test actors, to help with problems in speech, and to cure hiccups. • *





EMERGENCE OF TONGUE-TWISRER

In World War II, the famous tongue twisters aimed to specific purpose after Germany occupied Poland. a password they used a twister that someone who was not Polish would have great difficulty in pronouncing correctly.






EMERGENCE OF TONGUE-TWISRER

- 3. French friars fanning a fainted flea.

- 5. The rat ran by the river with a lump of raw liver.






CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES OF TONGUE-TWISRER

Children will enjoy listening to the repeated sounds. When it comes to the period that one can remember the meaning, they will be able to recognize the definition and comprehend what does that word imply








CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES OF TONGUE-TWISRER
