we use PRESENT CONTINUOUS

EASY PATTERN:

is are (-ing) C am

PRESENT CONTINUOUS (or Present Progressive)



examples:

is writing are performing am explaining

PRESENT CONTINUOUS (or Present Progressive)

Sample sentences: 1. She is shopping online. 2. Alex is collecting records. 3. Mom is baking some cupcakes.












To talk about one's hobbies, we may use WORD COLLOCATION like:

playing soccer/ to play soccer doing pilates/ to do pilates going to the gym/ to go to the gym shopping online/ to shop online playing video games/ to play video games

COLLOCATIONS:

a group of two or more words that are almost always put together to create a specific meaning

play video games

- go fishing
- do yoga
- play soccer
- go skiing
