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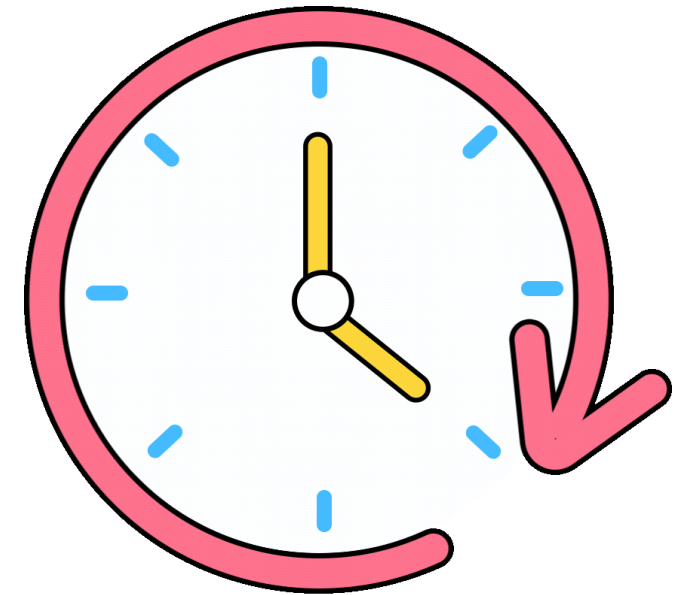

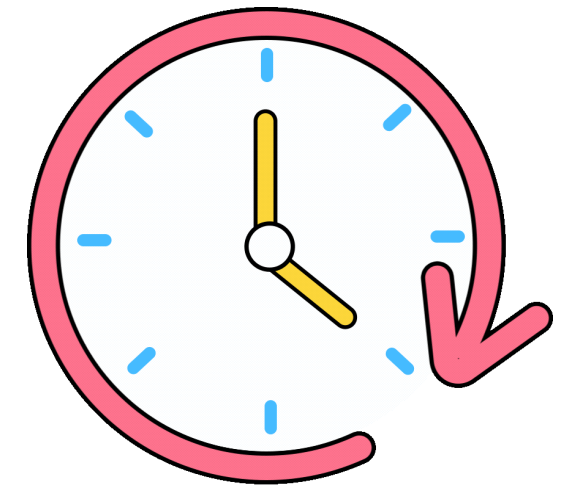

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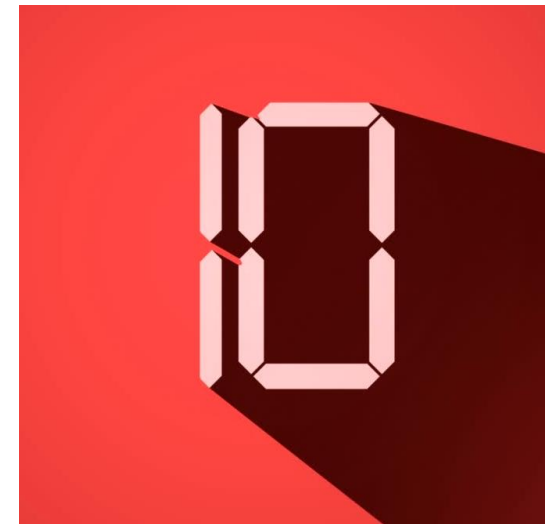

Answers

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Grammar- Usage of Present Perfect ever/never



Ever - is used to ask or talk about whether something has happened at any time in a person's life up to now.

- **Have you ever been to Japan? (Asking about experience)**
- **Has she ever tried sushi? (Asking about experience)**

Never - is used to express that something hasn't happened at any time up to the present moment.

- **I have never seen such a beautiful sunset before. (Indicating lack of experience)**
- **They have never tasted Italian food. (Indicating lack of experience)**

Note: “Ever” is typically used in questions and negatives not in positive sentences

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~~She has ever tried sushi.~~
