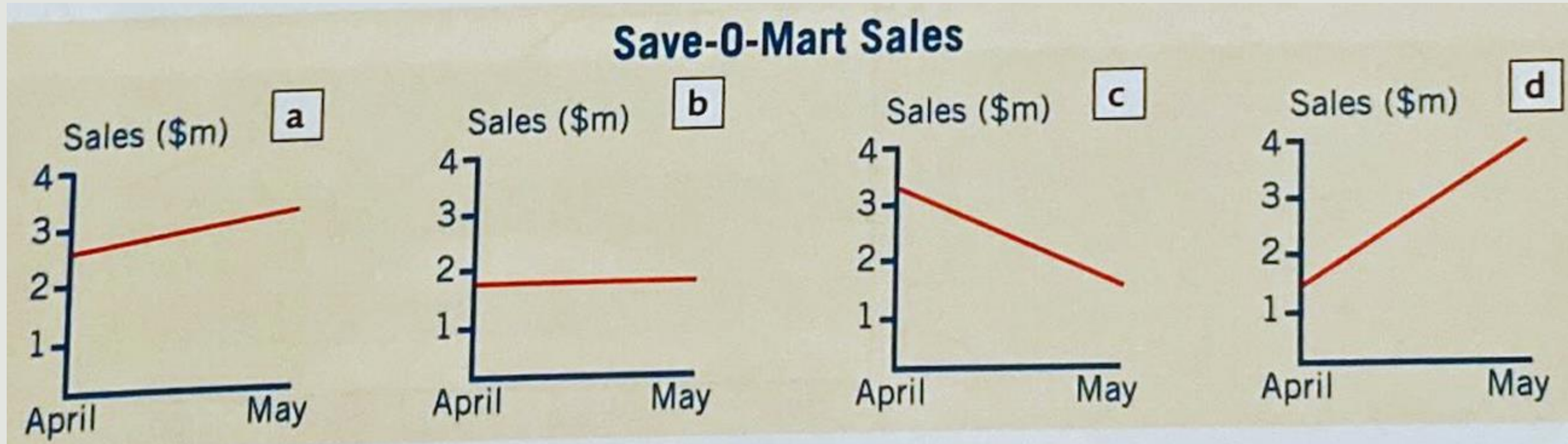

Highlighting similarities:

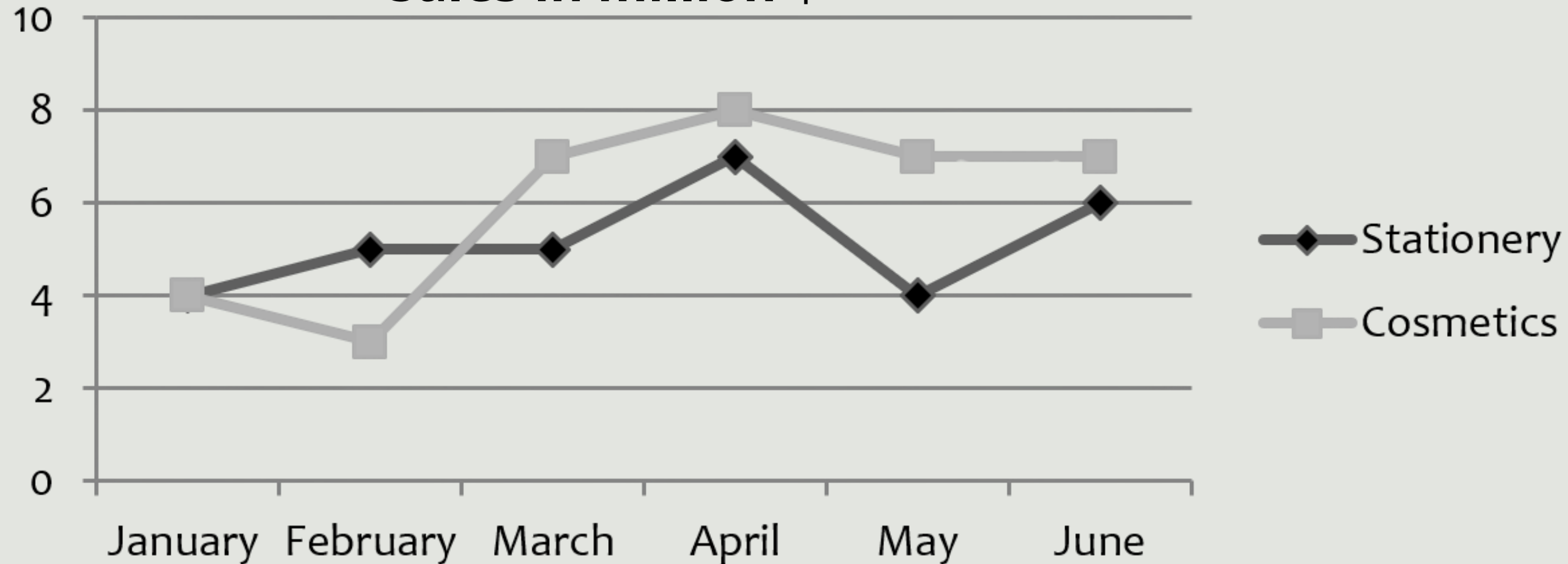
- **Both** products had steady sales in March.
- Stationery and Cosmetics sales **were nearly the same** in May.

Highlighting differences:

- Stationery sales went up, **but** Cosmetics stayed the same.
- Cosmetics sales dropped in April, **while** Stationery sales went up.

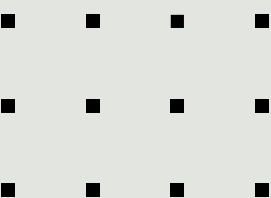

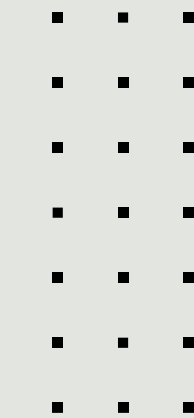
