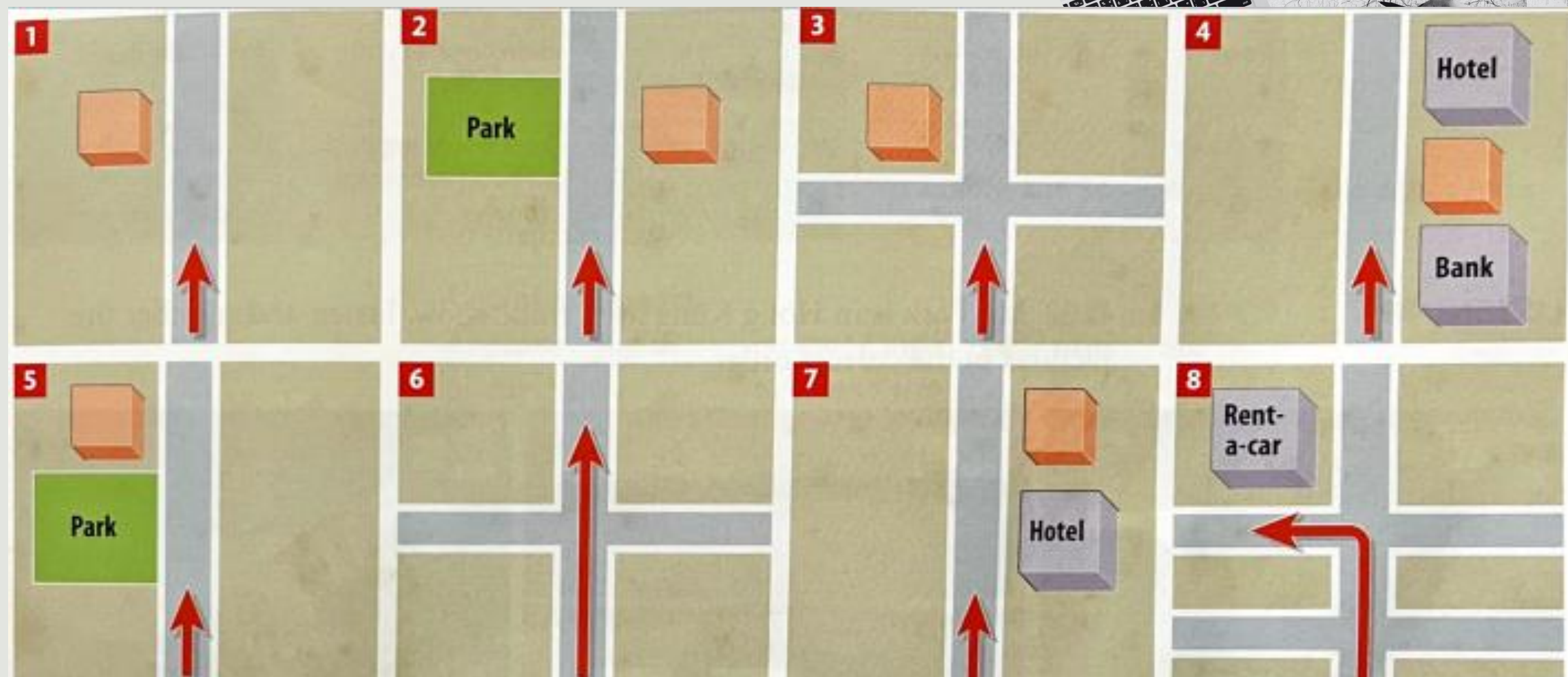


Match the sentences (a-f) with the maps below (1-8).

Declining an invitation politely

- Thank you for inviting me, but I'm afraid I can't make it.
- I appreciate the offer, but I have a prior commitment.
- Thanks, but I'm not available that day.
- I'd love to, but unfortunately, I have other plans.
- I'm sorry, but I won't be able to attend. Let's catch up another time!
