

Mark: I was wondering if you're free this Saturday.

Anna: Let me check... Yes, I'm free in the afternoon.

Mark: Great! Do you want to go see a movie or hang out at the park?

Anna: A movie sounds fun. What time should we meet?

Mark: How about 2 p.m. at the cinema?

Anna: Perfect. See you then!

Mark: See you! Bye!
