Jennie : Oh, I like the blue one. Do you have it in size M?

**Shop Assistant:** Let me check... Yes, here you go. Would you like to try it on?

Jennie : Yes, please. Where's the fitting room?

Shop Assistant: It's right over there.

Jennie : (After trying it on) It fits well! How much is it?

Shop Assistant: It's 350 baht.

Jennie : I'll take it.
