My brothers would like to have seafood pasta.

Those women would like to try a new sushi restaurant.

Fred wouldn't like to order pizza.

Grammar Point

How to use, "would like to".

Subject	+ would like	+ noun
	+ wouldn't like	

E.g.

His girl friend would like a glass of mineral water.

Mr. Alex and his wife would like grilled salmon with cheese.

Sarah <u>wouldn't like</u> any garlic on her food.
