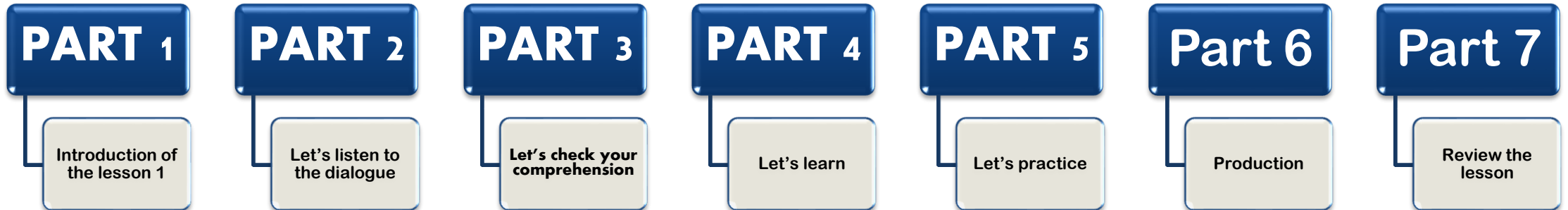

B: It is to take Bus 88 from here.

- Walk about 10 minutes** from here, then **you will see** the post office on your **left hand**.
- Go along** this street, then **turn right**. **Walk pass the** flower shop.
The hospital **will be in front of you**.

Public Transport

-Take the number 30 bus from that stop. Get off at the third stops. The mall will be on your right.
