Prepositions of Place

Subject	+ be (is am are)	+ preposition	+ object

E.g.

The hospital is near the supermarket.

The bank is next to the police station.

The students **are** in front of the school gate.

Grammar Point

Prepositions of Place

on	under	in	near	behind
between (and)	below	next to	above	in front of

E.g.

The bird is above the tree.

The shoes are below the shelf.

All tourists are behind the bus.
